ADD32011-1 is given here as a baseline example. This modular availability approach applies generally to most digitally printed Singles & Special Editions.

ADD32011-1* – FB.VI(c) RS838, RS851, & RS856 of 404 Sqn, Coastal Cmnd (rocket armed)
Full set: Codes, serials, and personal markings featuring nose art for each of these aircraft, and including the complete National Markings set, ADD32c105-1.

ADD32011-1x* – FB.VI(c) RS838, RS851, & RS856 of 404 Sqn, Coastal (rocket armed)
Basic set: Codes, serials, and personal markings as above but excluding the National Markings (typically preferred by model makers who use paint masks or kit decals for the national markings).

ADD32011-1s – FB.VI(c) RS838, RS851, & RS856 of 404 Sqn, Coastal (rocket armed)
Full set+: Codes, serials, and personal markings as per the Full Set above, including the complete National Markings set, ADD32c105-1 as well as Airframe Stencil Data Markings set, ADD32s105 in the same package.

ADD32011-1xs – FB.VI(c) RS838, RS851, & RS856 of 404 Sqn, Coastal (rocket armed)
Basic set+: Codes, serials, and personal markings as per the Basic Set above, excluding the complete National Markings set, ADD32c105-1, but including ADD32s105.

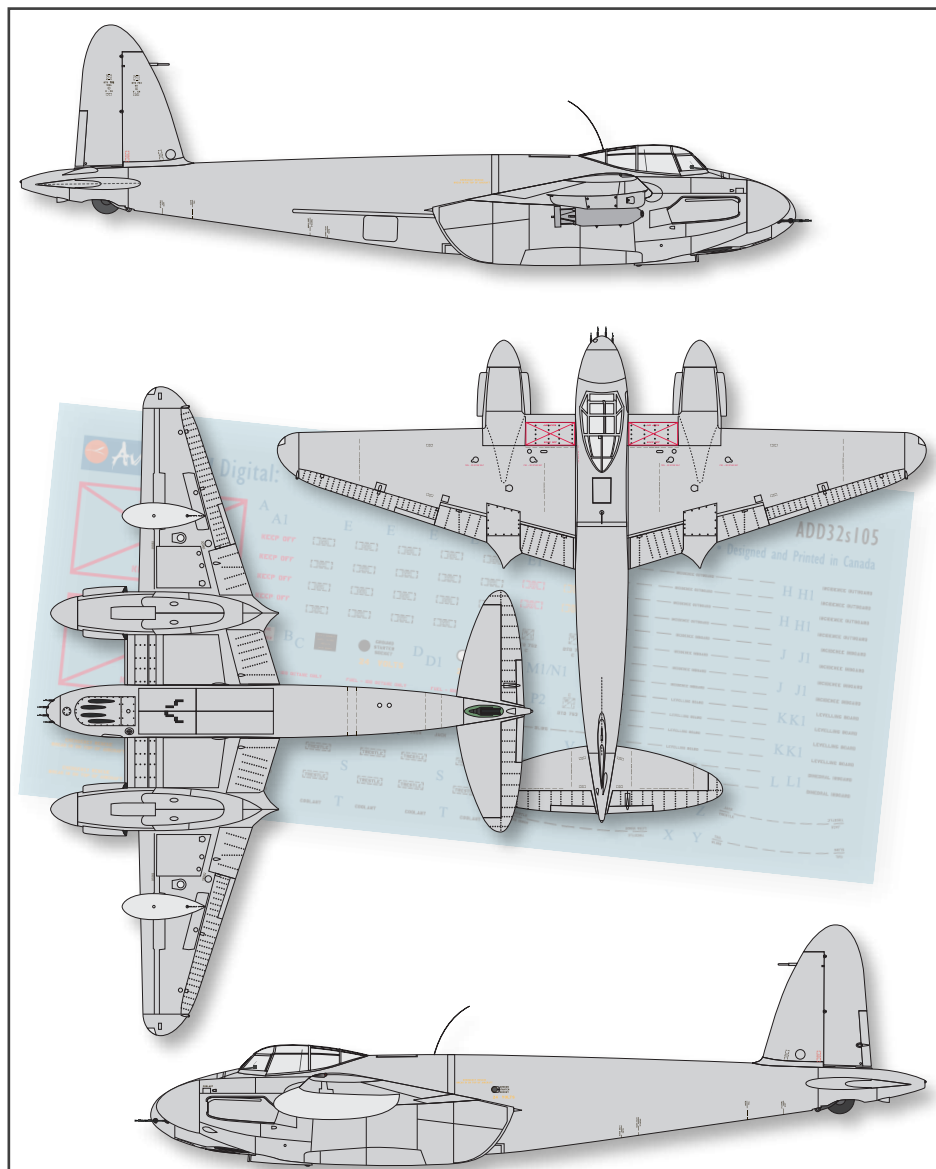
ADD32c105-1s, 2s, or 3s – Mosquito National Markings (any one of these three different sets)
National Markings set+: ADD32s105 ASDM with any one of the Mosquito National Markings sets in the same package.

Bold text indicates that the set has already been released in at least one scale.

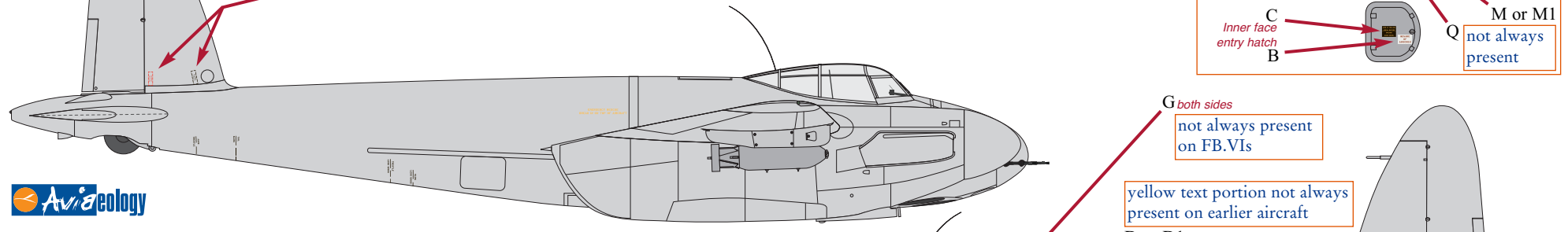
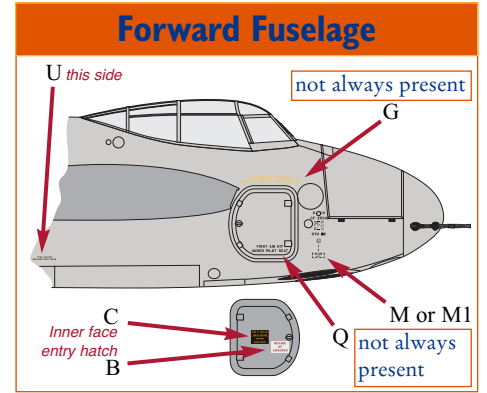
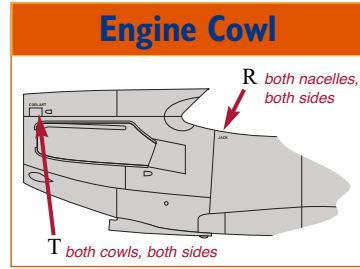
Mosquito Airframe Stencil Data Markings (part 1) - all marks



This package contains an extensive range of airframe maintenance / data markings, including a number of factory and field-applied variations that have been observed for some of the individual elements. This set is compatible with all Mosquito finish schemes except the early-war overall Night (Matte Black) nightfighter scheme. Includes enough to complete at least one 1/32 scale model with detailed application instructions.

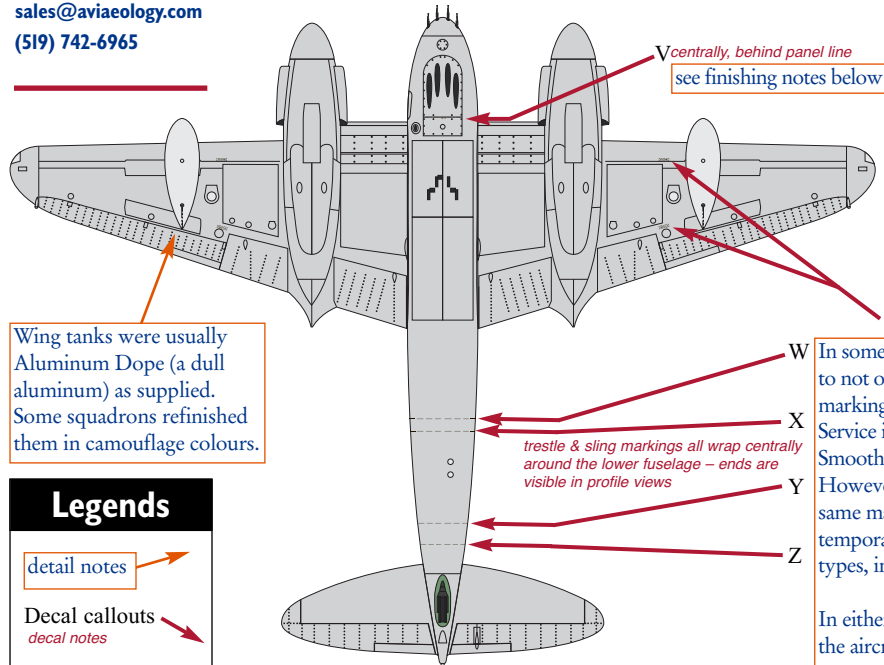
Mosquito airframe stencil / data markings

NOTE: Where variations in markings styles have been found during research, alternates are provided in this set. Alternates have the same callout letter, but are suffixed with a number. The first is the preferred choice (seen most often in reference photos, while the alternates observed less often). Also note that some items may not have been applied (or reapplied after maintenance, etc) at all times. As always, consult available reference materials for your individual subject aircraft.

In some squadrons, care was apparently taken to not overpaint some factory-applied stencil markings on some FB.VIs refinished by the Service in the early Intruder scheme with Smooth Night (Matte Black) undersides. However, later on (after early June 1944), these same markings were often obscured by the temporary AEF stripes on many aircraft types, including Mosquitoes.

In either case, a check of reference photos of the aircraft being modelled is recommended.
